

## Installing and Configuring AutoValue/Bumper to Bumper MyPlaceForParts within RO Writer Version 2.60 or greater

## **Prerequisites**

RO Writer 2.60 or greater

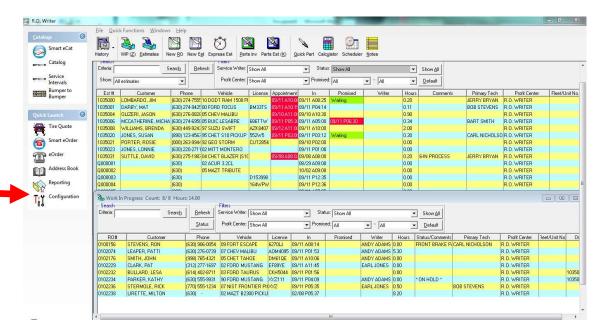
Seller ID / Buyer ID provided by your Auto parts Supplier. If you do not know your Seller ID / Buyer ID please contact your Parts Store.

## Installation

There is no installation required.

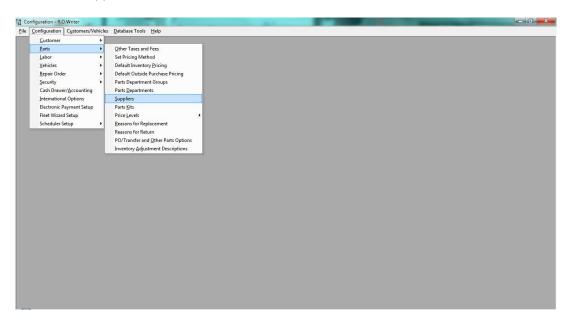
To configure RO Writer you must be at least in Version 2.60 or greater and have your Seller ID / Buyer ID provided BY YOUR PARTS SUPPLIER.

1, Click on Configuration. (Version 2.60 will have a blue tint screen. This is a screen shot of a prior version, but the screen is the same)

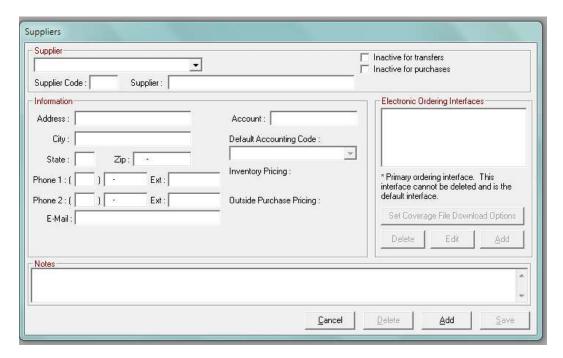




2. Click on Parts / Suppliers

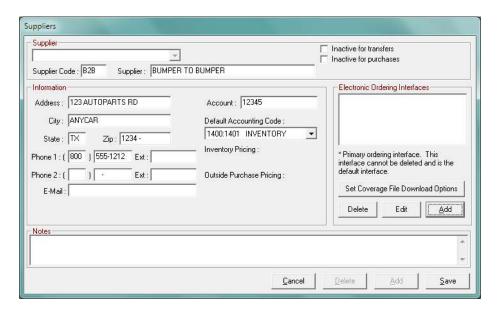


3. Click to dropdown box to see if the supplier already exists or Create a new one.

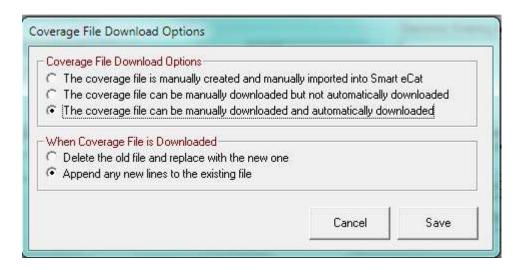




4. To add a new one, enter a Supplier Code and a Supplier Name.



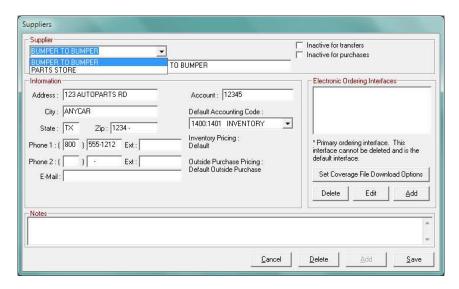
5. Set the Coverage Download Options It can manually and Automatically be downloaded.



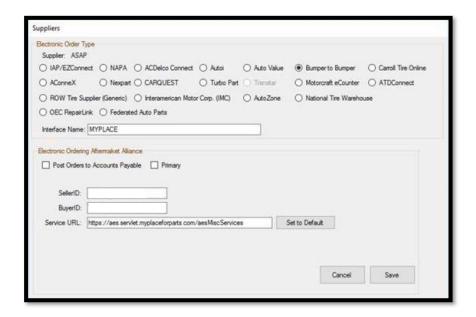
6. Click Save
